



RESOLUTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND GLOBAL WARMING

ACCRA, Ghana

2 - 4 March 2018

1. Recognizing the significant negative impact of climate change and global warming in Africa causing devastating drought, the loss of jobs, migration, economic and social instability, and the negative impact on the economic development of Africa.
2. Acknowledging the current water crisis and drought in Cape Town, South Africa negatively affecting the provincial economy and tourism, that leads to job losses.

Africa Liberal Network therefore:

- i) Calls on ALN member parties to raise awareness about the reality and negative effects of climate change and global warming.
- ii) Further calls on ALN member parties to raise awareness of water conservation and preservation awareness campaigns in their respective countries and parliaments.
- iii) Notes the current water crisis in Cape Town, South Africa and its negative impact on the economy and tourism sector.
- iv) Acknowledges the UN and AU efforts in reaching an amicable agreement on climate change (COP17)
- v) Applauds the work done by the DA led government in Western Cape and City of Cape Town to avoid Day Zero and coordinate efforts of water conservation.
- vi) Further calls on the international community to raise awareness about water conservation and to engage in efforts to mitigate the effects of climate change and global warming.
